Hartz Flea and Tick Repellent prevents these pests from actually inhabiting your cat. In laboratory and field tests, animals treated with this spray repelled fleas and ticks for up to 21 days. The spray may also be used on pets infested with fleas or ticks in order to kill these parasites and prevent additional ones from inhabiting the pet.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

To repel fleas and ticks, thereby reducing incidence of itching and scratching, hold container 6 to 10 inches from animal and spray over entire body. Be sure to cover feet and tail. Do not spray in eyes. For best penetration of spray to the skin, direct spray against the natural lay of the fur to cause fluffing of the coat. Under normal circumstances, repeat spray every 21 days. In areas or periods of heavy infestation it may be necessary to treat the cat more frequently. Under such circumstances, an occasional flea or tick may be seen on the animal. For more prolonged flea and tick control, the animal's bedding, quarters, and surrounding area should also be sprayed lightly until damp to help prevent reinfestation. Complete control can be obtained by affixing a Hartz 2 in 1[®] Reflecting Collar to the pet in addition to use of this spray.

Storage and Disposal: Do not contaminate water, food or feed by storage and disposal. Wrap empty container and put in trash collection.

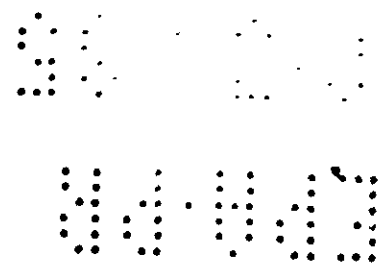
