- d. "Fenvalerate" is not an approved common name for Pydrin. Therefore, the ingredient statement must declare fenvalerate as follows:

Cyano (3-phenoxyphenyl) methyl-4-chloro-alpha-(1-methylethyl) benzeneacetate.

The above correction should also be made at the next printing of your other product labels (EPA Registration Nos. 2596-104 and 2596-103).

- e. Add the subheading "Storage and Disposal" above the Storage and Disposal statement. In addition, the statement should be revised to read,

Replace cap and securely wrap original container in several layers of newspaper and discard in trash.

3. Submit five (5) copies of your final printed labeling before you release the product for shipment. Refer to the A-79 Enclosure for a further description of final printed labeling.

If these conditions are not complied with, the registration will be subject to cancellation in accordance with FIFRA section 6(e). Your release for shipment of the product constitutes acceptance of these conditions.

The spray may also be used on dogs with fleas or ticks in order to kill these parasites and prevent them from inhabiting the pet.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

To repel fleas and ticks, thereby reducing incidence of itching and scratching, hold container 6 to 10 inches from animal and spray over entire body to cover feet and tail. Do not spray in eyes. For best penetration into skin, direct spray against the natural lay of the fur to cause matting. Under normal circumstances, repeat spray every 21 days. In periods of heavy infestation it may be necessary to treat the cat more frequently. Under such circumstances, an occasional flea or tick may bite the animal. For more prolonged flea and tick control, the animal's quarters, and surrounding area should also be sprayed lightly. This will help prevent reinfestation. Complete control can be obtained by using Hartz 2 in 1 Reflecting Collar to the cat in addition to use of this repellent. **Storage and Disposal: Replace cap and discard in trash. Do not incinerate or pour down drain.**
