The above correction should also be made at the next printing of your other product labels (EPA Registration Nos. 2596-104 and 2596-103).

- e. Add the subheading "Storage and Disposal" above the Storage and Disposal statement. In addition, the statement should be revised to read:

Replace cap and securely wrap original container in several layers of newspaper and discard in trash.

3. Submit five (5) copies of your final printed labeling before you release the product for shipment. Refer to the A-79 Enclosure for a further description of final printed labeling.
