

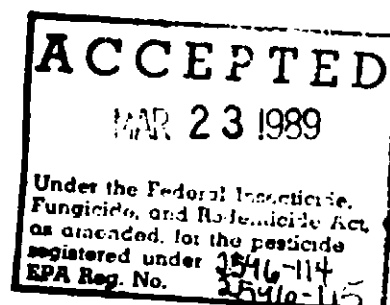

This supplement contains additional directions precautions which may not appear on the container label. All additional directions precautions on this supplement are to be followed carefully.

Directions For Use

It is a violation of Federal Law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

- Do not use Blockade Cat Flea and Tick Repellent on young (less than one year old) or pregnant cats.
- Do not use Blockade Dog Flea & Tick Repellent on young (less than 3 months old) puppies.

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- Apply lightly. Do not saturate animal's coat. Spray approximately two seconds for each pound of pet's body weight.
- Do Not apply more often than every seven days.
- Some animals may be sensitive to ingredients in this or similar pesticide products. Pet should be observed following treatment. If salivation, tremors, or vomiting occur after treatment, pet should immediately be bathed with a non-pesticidal shampoo and wrapped in a towel to prevent chilling and taken to a veterinarian along with the product container.
- Do not use this or any other pesticide on sick, old or debilitated pets.

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
