DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal law to use
this product in a manner inconsistent
with its labeling.

To repel fleas and ticks, hold con-
tainer 6 to 10 inches from animal and
spray over entire body, including feet
and tail. Do not spray in eyes. Apply
lightly. Spray approximately two
seconds for each pound of pet's
body weight. For best results, direct
spray against the natural lay of the fur
to cause fluffing of the coat. Do not
apply more often than every seven
days. In periods of heavy infestations,
occasional fleas or ticks may be seen

on the animal. For added protection,
the animal's bedding, quarters and
surrounding area should also be
sprayed lightly until damp to help
prevent reinfestation. For continuous
control use the Hartz 2 in 1* Collar on
your pet in addition to use of this
spray. Do not expose your dog to
other pet, house or garden insecti-
cides when using this product.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL—Wrap empty
container and put in trash.
