1. Submit and/or cite all data or other material required for registration/reregistration of your product under FIFRA sec. 3(c)(5) or FIFRA sec. 4 when the Agency requires all registrants of similar products to submit such data.

2. Make the labeling change listed below before you release the product for shipment:

- Add the phrase, "EPA Registration No. 2596-119."
- Your product contains one active ingredient. Therefore change Active Ingredients to Active Ingredient.
- Under Environmental Hazards add the following: "Do not contaminate water when disposing of dip solution."

3. The dermal toxicity study submitted December 1, 1992 is guideline data in category IV toxicity. The Agency agrees that this product does not pose any inhalation hazard in the way it is used. The requested waiver for acute inhalation is granted.

Category IV classification of eye irritation potential does not require any precautionary statements about eye irritation. However, you may retain the current labeling if you choose.

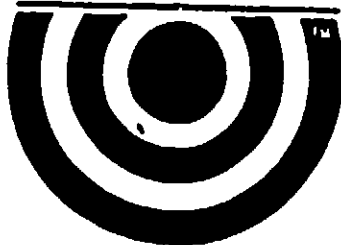

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

For control of ticks, flea and lice on dogs and cats, dilute 2 ounces of Hartz 2 in 1 Dip with 1 gallon of water. Dip animal into solution, making sure hair is thoroughly wet to the skin. The area around the ears should be sponged thoroughly. Avoid contact of material with eyes and mouth of animal. Do not rinse. Towel dry. Repeat as necessary for control.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

Storage: Store in a cool place, away from heat or open flame.

Disposal: Do not reuse empty container. Wrap container and put in trash collection. Do not contaminate water, food or feed stuffs by storage or disposal of this concentrate or dip.

PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS

Caution: Avoid contact with eyes. It is good practice to wash thoroughly with soap and water after handling any pesticide. It is inadvisable to use this or similar pesticides on kittens or puppies under 6 weeks of age.
