For control on dogs and cats of fleas, lice and ticks, including the Deer Tick which may carry Lyme Disease, dilute 2 ounces of Dip with 1 gallon of water. Dip animal into solution, or sponge solution on, making sure hair is thoroughly wet to the skin. The area around the ears should be sponged thoroughly. Avoid contact of material with eyes and mouth of animal. Do not rinse. Towel dry. Repeat as necessary for control.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL:

Storage: Store in a cool place, away from heat or open flame. **Disposal:** Do not reuse empty container. Wrap container and put in trash collection. Do not contaminate water, food or feed stuffs by storage or disposal of this concentrate or dip.

Toxic to fish. Do not contaminate water when disposing of dip solution.

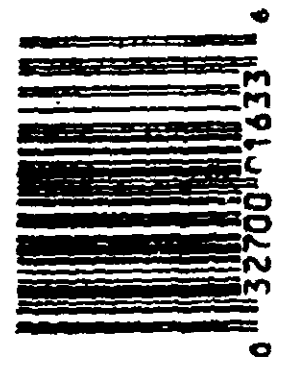
