Your Submissions Dated January 6, and January 7, 1992

The labeling referred to above, submitted in connection with registration under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide, and Rodenticide Act, as amended, is acceptable, provided that you make the labeling changes listed below before you release the product for shipment bearing the amended labeling:

In the above letters, item B, you indicate that the nominal concentration for esfenvalerate is 0.025%, yet the lower certified limit is 0.027. Note that the nominal concentration should be a value between the upper and lower certified limits, not less than the lower certified limit; in addition, the upper and lower certified limits should be based on the pure active ingredient rather than the technical or concentrate. Please adjust the label or Confidential Statement of Formula accordingly.

Submit five copies of your final printed labeling before you release the product for shipment.

A stamped copy of the labeling is enclosed for your records.

In areas of extremely heavy infestations, it may be necessary to spray more frequently. This spray may also be used on pets infested with fleas or ticks in order to kill these parasites within several hours.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

To repel fleas and ticks, hold container 6 to 10 inches from animal and spray over entire body, including feet and tail. Do not spray in eyes. Apply lightly. Do not saturate animal's coat. Spray approximately two seconds for each pound of pet's body weight. For best results, direct spray against the natural lay of the fur to cause fluffing of the coat. Do not apply more often than every seven days. In periods of

heavy infestations, occasional fleas or ticks may be seen on the animal. For added protection, the animal's bedding, quarters and surrounding area should also be sprayed until damp to help prevent reinfestation. For continuous control use Hartz 2 in 1 Collar on your pet in addition to use of this spray. Do not use your dog or other pet, household insecticides when using this product.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL—Do not contaminate water, food or feed. Empty container and put in trash. Do not puncture or incinerate container.

PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENT—Hazards to Humans & Domestic Animals

CAUTION: Apply spray in a well-ventilated area. Avoid inhalation of spray. Avoid spraying in eyes. Do not use on animal until spray has dried. It is good practice to wash hands after use. Do not use on pregnant dogs or young (less than three months old) puppies. Do not use this or any other pesticide on sick, old or debilitated pets. Some animals may be sensitive to ingredients in this or other pesticide products. Pets should be observed following treatment. If any unusual symptoms occur, immediately treat pet with a non-pesticidal shampoo. If symptoms do not subside within one hour, consult your veterinarian.
