For best penetration of spray to the skin, direct spray against the natural lay of the hair to cause fluffing of the coat. In addition to controlling fleas and ticks, this product leaves your pet's coat soft, glossy and manageable.

Under normal circumstances, repeat spray once every few days until infestation is brought under control, then repeat as necessary. For more prolonged flea and tick control, the animal's bedding, quarters, and surrounding area should also be sprayed lightly until damp to help prevent reinfestation.

Storage and disposal: Do not contaminate water, food or feed by storage and disposal. Wrap empty container and put in trash collection.
