You continue to be subject to existing conditions on your registration and any deadlines connected with them.

A stamped copy of your labeling is enclosed for your records. This labeling supersedes all previously accepted labeling. You must submit one copy of the final printed labeling before you release the product for shipment with the new labeling. In accordance with 40 CFR 152.130(c), you may distribute or sell this product under the previously approved labeling for 18 months from the date of this letter. After 18 months, you may only distribute or sell this product if it bears this new revised labeling or subsequently approved labeling. "To distribute or sell" is defined under FIFRA section 2(gg) and its implementing regulation at 40 CFR 152.3.

Should you wish to add/retain a reference to the company's website on your label, then please be aware that the website becomes labeling under the Federal Insecticide Fungicide and Rodenticide Act and is subject to review by the Agency. If the website is false or misleading, the product would be misbranded and unlawful to sell or distribute under FIFRA section 12(a)(1)(E). 40 CFR 156.10(a)(5) list examples of statements EPA may consider false or misleading. In addition, regardless of whether a website is referenced on your product's label, claims made on the website may not substantially differ from those claims approved through the registration process. FIRST AID

This product contains tetrachlorvinphos (an organophosphate) which is a cholinesterase inhibitor.

If on skin or clothing •Take off contaminated clothing. •Rinse skin immediately with plenty of water for 15-20 minutes. •Call a poison control center or doctor for treatment advice.

If in eyes •Hold eye open and rinse slowly and gently with water for 15-20 minutes. •Remove contact lenses, if present, after the first 5 minutes, then continue rinsing eye. •Call a poison control center or doctor for treatment advice.

If swallowed •Call poison control center or doctor immediately for treatment advice.

•Have person sip a glass of water if able to swallow. •Do not induce vomiting unless told to do so by the poison control center or doctor. •Do not give anything by mouth to an unconscious person.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

SHAKE WELL BEFORE USE

- 1. Hold bottle upright about 6 inches from pet.
- 2. Spray lightly until the tips of the pet's hair are moist. Keep spray out of pet's eyes.
- 3. Rub spray into animal's coat. For longhaired dogs, ruffle fur to allow the spray to reach skin.
- 4. After 10 minutes, dry dog with towel.
- 5. Comb and brush coat.
- 6. Repeat once a week.
- 7. If you see a tick, spray it directly.
- 8. Use on bedding and other areas as needed.

Recommended dosage: Spray 25-30 strokes for a small dog (e.g. Terrier). Spray 30-40 strokes for a medium dog (e.g. Spaniel). Spray 40-70 strokes for a large dog (e.g. Labrador). More spray may be needed for longhaired dogs.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

Do not contaminate water, food or feed by storage and disposal.

Pesticide Storage: Keep this product in its tightly closed original container, when not in use. Store in a cool, dry (preferably locked) area that is inaccessible to children and animals.

Container Disposal: If empty: Nonrefillable container. Do not reuse or refill this container. Offer for recycling, if available. **If partly filled:** Call your local solid waste agency for disposal instructions. Never place unused product down any indoor or outdoor drain.
