STATEMENT OF PRACTICAL TREATMENT

If swallowed, drink one or two glasses of water and induce vomiting by touching the back of the throat with finger. Repeat until vomit fluid is clear. Call a physician immediately. Do not induce vomiting or give anything by mouth to an unconscious person.

If inhaled—remove victim to fresh air. Apply respiration if necessary.

ENVIRONMENTAL HAZARDS

This product is highly toxic to fish. DIRECTIONS FOR USE

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

Do not contaminate water, food or feed by storage or disposal. Do not reuse empty container.

STORAGE: Store in a dry place in original container. In case of spill, use large amounts of water. Decontaminate areas and equipment with a dilute solution of alkali (less than 5%) and detergent and water.

PESTICIDE DISPOSAL: Pesticide that cannot be used or is no longer needed should be disposed of at an approved waste disposal facility.

CONTAINER DISPOSAL: Completely empty liner by shaking and tapping to loosen clinging particles. Empty residues into mixing tank or sanitary landfill or by incineration if allowed by state and local authorities in the same manner.
