On the basis of information furnished by the registrant, the above named pesticide is hereby registered/reregistered under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide and Rodenticide Act. Registration is in no way to be construed as an endorsement or recommendation of this product by the Agency. In order to protect health and the environment, the Administrator, on his motion, may at any time suspend or cancel the registration of a pesticide in accordance with the Act. The acceptance of any name in connection with the registration of a product under this Act is not to be construed as giving the registrant a right to exclusive use of the name or to its use if it has been covered by others.

Based on your response to the Reregistration Eligibility Documents, EPA has reregistered the product listed above. Enclosed is a copy of your label stamped "Accepted with Comments". This action is taken under the authority of section 4(g)(2) of the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide, and Rodenticide Act, as amended. Registration under this section does not eliminate the need for control reassessment of pesticides. EPA may require submission of data at any time to maintain the registration of your product.

With regards to labeling, you must make the labeling changes listed below.

- 1) Based upon the toxicity profile for this product:
 - a) The Statement of Practical Treatment must be revised as per the Acute Toxicity studies. It should state the following:

IF SWALLOWED: Call a physician or Poison Control Center. Drink 1 or 2 glasses of water and induce vomiting by touching back of throat with finger, or, if available, by administering syrup of ipecac. If person is unconscious, do not give anything by mouth and do not induce vomiting.

IF ON SKIN: Wash with plenty of soap and water. Get medical attention.

IF IN EYES: Flush eyes with plenty of water. Call a physician if irritation persists.

IF INHALED: Remove victim to fresh air. If not breathing, give artificial respiration, preferably mouth to mouth. Get medical attention.

If swallowed, drink one or two glasses of water and induce vomiting by touching the back of the throat with finger. Repeat until vomit fluid is clear. Call a physician immediately. Do not induce vomiting or give anything by mouth to an unconscious person. If inhaled - remove victim to fresh air. Apply respiration if necessary. If on skin - remove contaminated clothing and wash affected areas with soap and water. If in eyes - flush eyes for at least 15 minutes with water. Call a physician if irritation persists.

PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS

HAZARDS TO HUMANS

CAUTION. Harmful if swallowed or absorbed through skin. May cause eye irritation. Avoid breathing dust. This product may cause skin sensitization reactions in certain individuals. Do not get in eyes, on skin or on clothing. Avoid prolonged contact with skin. Wash thoroughly with soap and water after handling and before eating and smoking.

PROTECTIVE CLOTHING

When mixing/loading or otherwise handling the concentrate, wear mid forearm to elbow length chemical resistance gloves, long sleeve shirt, anlong pants. For medical emergencies involving this product call 201-271-4800.

ENVIRONMENTAL HAZARDS

This product is highly toxic to fish. Do not discharge effluent containing this product into lakes, streams, ponds, estuaries, oceans, or public waters unless this product is specifically identified and addressed in an National Pollutant Discharge Elimination System (NPDES) permit. Do not discharge effluent containing this product to sewer systems without previously notifying the sewage treatment plant authority. DIRECTIONS FOR USE

This pesticide may be used only for formulation into end-use insecticide products intended for domestic indoor use. This product may be used to formulate products for any additional uses not listed on the MP label if the formulator, user group or grower has complied with U.S. EPA data submission requirements regarding the support of such uses. Refer to available Technical Bulletin for formulating and other information.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

Do not contaminate water, food or feed by storage or disposal. Open dumping is prohibited. Do not reuse empty container.

STORAGE: Store in a dry place in original container. In case of spillage, wash down with large amounts of water. Decontaminate areas and equipment by washing down with a dilute solution of alkali (less than 5%) and detergent and rinse with water.

PESTICIDE DISPOSAL: Pesticide that cannot be used or chemically reprocessed should be disposed of at an approved waste disposal facility.

CONTAINER DISPOSAL: Completely empty liner by shaking and tapping sides and bottom to loosen clinging particles. Empty residues into mixing equipment. Dispose of liner in a sanitary landfill or by incineration if allowed by state and local authorities. Dispose of container in the same manner.
