NOTE TO PHYSICIAN: This product contains an organophosphate and may cause cholinesterase inhibition. If symptoms of cholinesterase inhibition are present, atropine sulfate by injection is antidotal. 2-PAM is also antidotal and may be administered, but only in conjunction with. HAZARDS TO HUMANS

CAUTION:

Harmful if swallowed or absorbed through skin. Causes eye irritation. Prolonged or frequently repeated skin contact may cause allergic reaction in some individuals. Wash thoroughly with soap and water after handling. Wash hands before eating, drinking, chewing gum, using tobacco, or using the toilet.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal Law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.
