Cholinergic symptoms may include salivation, missis, incoordination, muscle fasciculation and/or weakness, vomiting and diarrhea. Atropine is antidotal. 2-PAM may be effective as an adjunct to atropine. Call 1-800-275-1414 or your local Poison Control Center for further information.

CAUTION: Harmful if swallowed, inhaled, or absorbed through skin. Causes moderate eye irritation. This product may cause skin sensitization reactions in certain individuals. Prolonged or frequently repeated skin contact may cause allergic reaction in some individuals. Remove and wash contaminated clothing before use.
