It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

Place the Hartz 330 Day Flea & Tick Collar around the dog's neck, adjust to proper fit and buckle in place. The collar must be worn loosely to allow for growth of the dog and to permit the collar to move about the neck. Generally, a properly fitted collar is one that when fastened will snugly slide over the dog's head. Leave 2 or 3 inches on the collar for extra adjustment and cut off and dispose of the extra length. Some animals may become irritated by any collar if it is applied too tightly. If this occurs loosen the collar. If irritation continues, remove the collar from the animal.

The collar's activity against fleas starts within 24 hours. Once the activity starts, the collar will provide effective flea kill for eleven (11) months. Ticks are harder to kill. Activity against ticks occurs within 3 days. Once the activity starts, this product will provide effective tick kill for seven (7) months, plus aiding in kill for an additional two (2) months. Fleas and ticks present in the animal's environment that may reappear on the dog will be killed and controlled within 24 hours. This collar also aids in the prevention and control of sarcoptic mange.

Under conditions where dogs are exposed to severe flea or tick infestations it may be necessary to replace the collar more frequently. Wetting will not impair the collar's effectiveness or the pet's protection. If the dog goes swimming or is out in the rain it is not necessary to remove the collar. The Hartz 330 Day Collar may be worn with a regular collar. If the collar becomes excessively dirty, wipe with a damp cloth. The pet's bedding and surroundings should also be treated for flea and tick control with a product suitable for this purpose.

**DISPOSAL**

Do not reuse pouch or box. Wrap pouch, box and excess collar and put in trash collection. When discarding used collar, wrap and place in trash.

**PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS**

**Hazards to Humans and Domestic Animals**

**CAUTION:** Do not open protective pouch until ready to use. This collar is intended for use as an insecticide generator. Not intended for use on humans. Wash hands thoroughly with soap and water after handling collar. Do not use on sick, extremely old or debilitated dogs. Do not use on dogs under 3 months of age. Do not use other pesticides or drugs on dogs while collar is worn.

This collar is a cholinesterase inhibitor. Some breeds or individuals may be sensitive. Remove collar if symptoms of cholinesterase inhibition (which may include salivating, vomiting and diarrhea) occur. **Note To Physician:** Atropine is antidotal only if symptoms of cholinesterase inhibition are present.

**If On Skin:** Wash thoroughly with soap and water.

**If In Eyes:** Flush with plenty of water.
