DIRECTIONS FOR USE: It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

SHAKE WELL BEFORE USE: To kill and repel fleas, ticks and lice (for 7 days) (for 1 week), (thereby reducing incidence of itching and scratching) and to kill flea eggs and prevent their hatching for 1 month (28 days) (4 weeks), hold container upright 6 inches from the animal and spray lightly over the entire body, pressing dispenser with quick short strokes. Move bottle to get even coverage of coat (until tips of hair are moist). Do not spray in eyes. Apply lightly and rub into coat. Ruffle hair for spray to reach skin. Once sprayed, fleas will be killed within 5 to 10 minutes. Ticks are tough - spray directly. After 10 minutes, dry animal with towel. Comb and brush coat. In addition to controlling fleas and ticks, this product leaves your pet's coat soft, glossy and manageable.

Under normal circumstances, to kill (adult) fleas and ticks, repeat spray once every few days until infestation is brought under control, then repeat as necessary. For more prolonged flea and tick control, the animal's bedding, quarters and surrounding area should also be sprayed lightly until damp to help prevent reinfestation.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL: Do not contaminate water, food or feed by storage and disposal. Do not re-use empty container. Wrap empty container and put in trash collection.
