Amended Labeling, Incorporation of Previously Rescinded Notification Language Hartz[®] Rabon[®] Spray with Methoprene Pump Formulation, EPA Reg. No. 2596-140 Your Submission Dated July 2, 2008

Dear Mr. Rosenwasser:

The labeling referred to above, submitted in connection with registration under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide and Rodenticide Act (FIFRA), as amended, is acceptable with the following provision(s):

Precautionary Statements section, Hazards to Humans and Domestic Animals subsection comment(s):

- 1. Replace the 4th sentence in paragraph 1 with: "Wash hands thoroughly with soap and water after handling and before eating, drinking, chewing gum, using tobacco or using the toilet."
- 2. Replace the 6th sentence with "Do not use on puppies ..." with: "Do not use on (puppies) (kittens) (puppies or kittens) less than twelve (12) weeks old."

First Aid Statement section, Note to Physicians and Veterinarians subsection comment(s):

- 3. It is important to note that the "1-800-275-1414" phone number should be available twenty-four (24) hours per day, seven (7) days per week for answering and responding to any medical emergencies or health concerns.
- 4. In the "Note to Physicians and Veterinarians:" subsection, replace the 1st sentence with: "This product contains tetrachlorvinphos (an organophosphate), which is a cholinesterase inhibitor."

Storage and Disposal Statement section comment(s):

5. To facilitate inclusion of language from PR Notice 2007-1, you should replace this section with:

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

Do not contaminate water, food or feed by storage and disposal.

Pesticide Storage: Store this product in a cool, dry place that is inaccessible to children. **Pesticide Disposal: If empty:** Nonrefillable container. Do not reuse or refill this container. Notice 20007-1] for disposal instructions. Never place unused product down any indoor or outdoor drain.

Please submit two (2) copies of the final printed labeling, incorporating the above changes, before releasing the product for shipment. DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

READ ENTIRE LABEL BEFORE EACH USE USE ONLY ON (DOGS) (CATS) (DOGS OR CATS)

SHAKE WELL BEFORE USE: To kill and repel fleas, ticks and lice for (7 days) (1 week), (thereby reducing incidence of itching and scratching) and to kill flea eggs and prevent their hatching for over (1 month) (28 days) (4 weeks), hold container upright 6 to 10 inches from the animal and spray lightly over the entire body (, pressing the dispenser with quick short strokes).

Move spray to get even coverage of coat until tips of hair are moist. Do not spray in eyes. Apply lightly and rub into coat. Ruffle hair for spray to reach skin. Once sprayed, fleas will be killed within 5 to 10 minutes. Ticks are tough—spray directly. In addition to controlling fleas and ticks, this product leaves your pet's coat soft, glossy, and manageable.

Under normal circumstances, to kill adult fleas and ticks, repeat spray once every few days until infestation is brought under control. For more prolonged flea and tick control, the animal's bedding, quarters and surrounding area should also be sprayed lightly until damp to help prevent reinfestation.
