Dear Ms. Masch:

The labeling referred to above, submitted in connection with registration under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide and Rodenticide Act (FIFRA), as amended, is acceptable with the following provision(s):

First Aid Statement section comment(s):

1. Within the "**HOT LINE NUMER**" subsection, revise the 2nd sentence to read "For additional information on this pesticide product (including health concerns, medical emergencies or pesticide incidents), you may call 1-800-275-1414." The "1-800-275-1414" phone number should be available twenty-four (24) hours per day, seven (7) days per week for answering and responding to any medical emergencies or health concerns.

Storage and Disposal Statement section comment(s):

- Revise the "Pesticide Storage:" subsection to read "Pesticide Storage: Do not store near heat or open flame.
 Keep this product in its tightly closed original container, when not in use. Store in a cool, dry (preferably locked) area that is inaccessible to children and animals."
- 3. Revise the existing subsection heading "Pesticide Disposal:" to read "Container Handling:"

Non-Pesticide Related Claims and Other Optional Text section comment(s):

- 4. Delete all newly added "Non-Pesticide Related and Other Optional Text" (marketing statements) that have been marked with "strikethrough."
- 5. You cannot market a product which is based on an alternate formulation, as per 40 CFR §152.43. If you want to add back these deleted marketing statements, you must submit a subsequent label amendment along with a revised basic CSF that actually contains "aloe" as an ingredient.

Should you wish to add/retain a reference to the company's website on your label, please be aware that the website becomes labeling under FIFRA and is subject to review by the Agency. If the website is false or misleading, the product would be misbranded and unlawful to sell or distribute under section 12(a)(1)(E) of FIFRA. 40 CFR §156.10(a)(5) lists examples of statements EPA may consider false or misleading. In addition, regardless of whether a website is referenced on your product's label, claims made on the website may not be substantially differ from those claims approved through the registration process. Therefore, should the Agency find, or if it is brought to our attention that a website contains false or misleading statements or claims substantially differing from the EPA-approved registration, the website will be referred to EPA's Office of Enforcement and Compliance Assurance (OECA). As an alternative, you may refer consumers to the company's phone number or e-mail address.
