Dear Mr. Rosenwasser:

The amendment referred to above, submitted in connection with registration under FIFRA section 3(c)(7)(A)6, is acceptable provided that you:

- (1) Submit three (3) copies of your final printed labeling before you release the product for shipment. Final printed labeling means the label or labeling of the product when distributed or sold. Clearly legible reproductions of photo reductions will be accepted for unusual labels, such as those silk-screened directly onto glass or metal containers or large bags or drum labels.
- (2) Submit and/or cite all data required for registration/reregistration of your product under FIFRA section 3(c) (5) when the Agency requires all registrants of similar products to submit such data.

If these conditions are not complied with, the registration will be subject to cancellation in accordance with FIFRA section 6(e). Your release for shipment of the product bearing the amended labeling constitutes acceptance of these conditions.

- 1. Use ONLY on cats or kittens over 12 weeks of age. DO NOT USE ON OTHER ANIMALS.
- 2. Remove one applicator tube from package and hold in an upright position pointed away from your face.
- 3. Pull off cap. Turn the cap around and place on top.
- 4. Simply press cap down to break the seal of the tube. Remove cap carefully.
- 5. Position the tip of the tube on the cat's back between the shoulder blades and squeeze out the entire contents of the tube.
- 6. Repeat every month.
