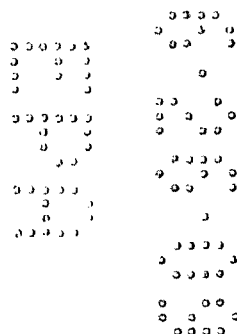

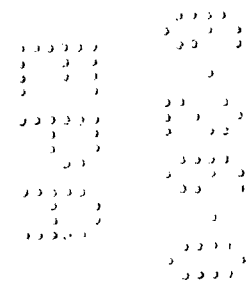

3. Pull off cap. Turn the cap around and place on top.
4. Simply press cap down to break the seal of the tube. Remove cap carefully.
5. Position the tip of the tube on the cat's back between the shoulder blades and squeeze out the entire contents of the tube.
6. Repeat every month.

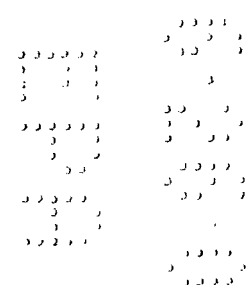
