In accordance with 40 CFR § 152.130(c), you may distribute or sell this product under the previously approved labeling for 18 months from the date of this letter. After 18 months, you may only distribute or sell this product if it bears this new revised labeling or subsequently approved labeling. "To distribute or sell" is defined under FIFRA section 2(gg) and its implementing regulation at 40 CFR § 152.3.

Should you wish to add/retain a reference to your company's website on your label, then please be aware that the website becomes labeling under FIFRA and is subject to review by the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency (EPA). If the website is false or misleading, the product will be considered to be misbranded and sale or distribution of the product is unlawful under FIFRA section 12(a)(1)(E). 40 CFR § 156.10(a)(5) lists examples of statements the EPA may consider false or misleading. - 3. Pull off cap. Turn the cap around and place on top.
- 4. Simply press cap down to break the seal of the tube. Remove cap carefully.
- 5. Position the tip of the tube on the cat's back between the shoulder blades and squeeze out the entire contents of the tube.
- 6. Repeat every month.

SIDE EFFECTS

Side Effects – Monitor your cat after application. Side effects may include signs of skin irritation such as redness, scratching, or other signs of discomfort.
