

(Direction Statement #1 - when product is packaged as a standard shampoo)

To kill fleas, lice and ticks, (including the Deer Tick which may carry Lyme Disease,) wet dog's coat throughly with water and rub shampoo into coat starting with head. Work backward until coat is completely covered with foamy lather. Let lather stay on 5 minutes, then rinse and towel dry.

(Direction Statement #2 - when product is packaged with a hose end sprayer)

- (1.) Make sure water control knob on hose sprayer is in the "OFF" position.
- (2.) Hold (the product) by handle and shake gently, turning bottle as you shake it.
- (3.) Attach hose to spray nozzle.
- (4.) Bend safety tab down and turn control to "WATER" position.
- (5.) Slowly turn on the water supply to any appropriate flow rate and pre-dampen the entire dog (animal).
- (6.) Turn the control knob to the "ON" position (shampoo will automatically begin to mix with the water).
- (7.) Apply the shampoo starting with the head [be careful not to spray in the dog's (cat's) eyes] and work backwards until the coat is completely covered with shampoo.
- (8.) Turn the sprayer to the "OFF" position and rub the shampoo into the coat with your hands so that a foamy lather is produced.
- (9.) Turn the spray nozzle to the "WATER" position and thoroughly rinse the animal.
- (10.) Turn the spray nozzle to the "OFF" position and disconnect from the hose for storage.

Repeat as required, but not more often than once a week. (It is recommended that the pet's bedding or sleeping quarters be treated for flea and tick control with a product registered for the use, such as Control Pet Care System Home Flea & Tick Killer.)
