 - The deletion of use not becoming effective earlier than October 31, 2005;
 - EPA not prohibiting Hartz from selling or distributing products with labels containing directions for use on cats from its facilities earlier than December 31, 2005;
 - The Agency allowing existing stocks for products with labels containing directions for use on cats until March 31, 2006, down to the retail level.
- Hartz Mountain will cease production of this product with labels containing directions for use on cats no later than September 30, 2005.
- Commencing April 1, 2006, for a period of six months, Hartz Mountain will provide RD with monthly reports on the status of existing stocks of products with labels containing directions for use on cats.

Submit two copies of the revised final printed label for the record.

If these conditions are not complied with, the registration will be subject to cancellation in accordance with FIFRA sec. 6(e). Your release for shipment of the product constitutes acceptance of these conditions.

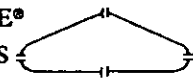

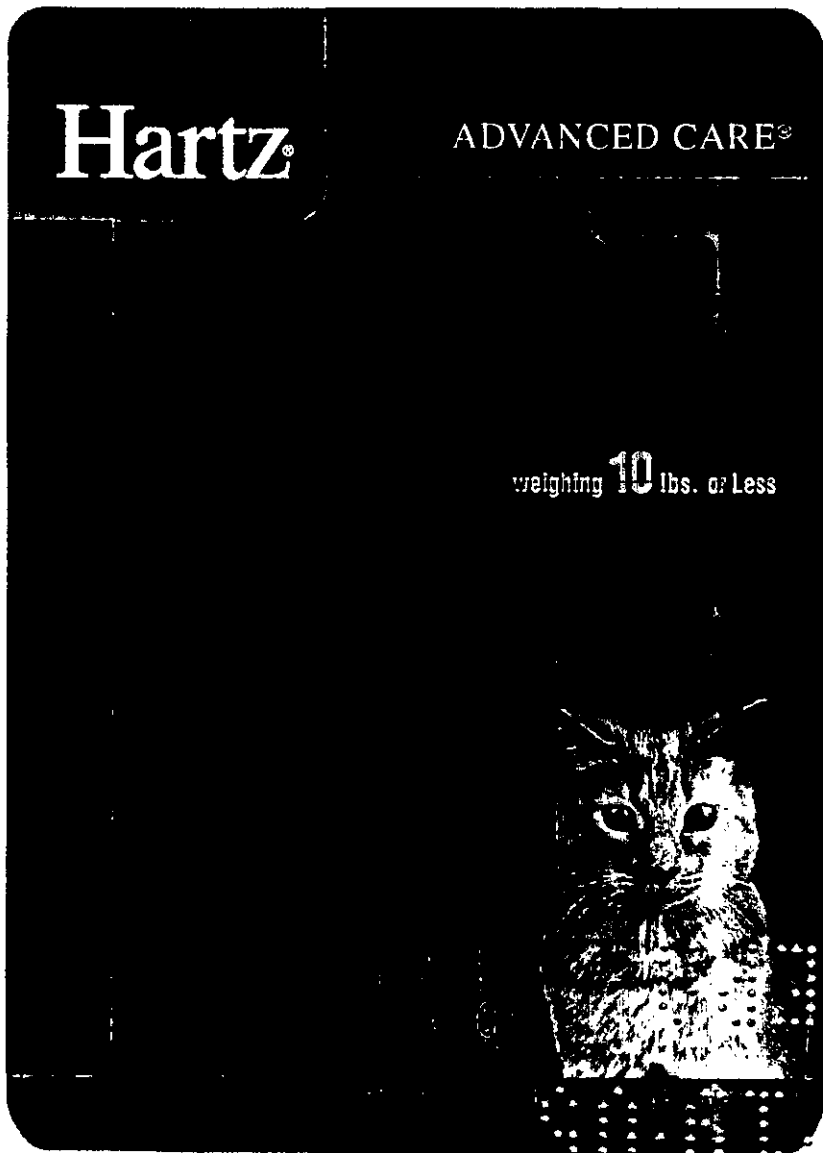
