Wet dog's coat thoroughly with water. Rub shampoo into coat, starting with head, at the rate of approximately 1 teaspoon (5 mL) for every 5 lbs of body weight. Work backward until coat is completely covered with foamy lather. Let lather stay on for 5 minutes, then rinse and towel dry. Keep away from dog's eyes. Repeat weekly (if necessary).

Consult a veterinarian before using this product on debilitated, aged, pregnant, nursing, or medicated animals.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL:

Do not contaminate water, food, or feed by storage and disposal. Store in a cool, dry place. If empty: Do not re-use this container. Place in trash or offer for recycling if available. If partly filled: Call your local solid waste agency or 1-800-CLEANUP for disposal instructions. Never place unused product down any indoor or outdoor drain.
