c. Please add a subheading of appropriate container size to each set of alternate brand names on page 1.

d. The label format is not clear as presented. Indicate what constitutes the front and back panels of each container size, and where rest of the statements will appear on each label.

e. On page 2, change the second statement as follows: "Use only on kittens over 12 weeks of age, and cats weighing 9 pounds or less."

f. On page 2, Hazards to Domestic Animals, change the first statement as follows: "For external use only on cats...kittens." Change the third statement under this heading as follows: "Do not use on kittens less than 12 weeks old or cats weighing over 9 pounds."

g. On page 4, Directions for Use, change the sixth statement as follows: "Use only on kittens over 12 weeks of age and cats weighing less than 9 pounds."

h. The alternate brand names given on the Tube Labeling for both sizes (pages 5 and 9) are not the same as the alternate brand names given on the front page. Alternate brand names on the outer package and the tube must match.

i. On page 6, change the second statement as follows: "Use only on cats over 6 months of age and weighing 9 pounds or over."

j. On page 6, Hazards to Domestic Animals, change the first statement as follows: "For external use only on cats." Change the third statement under this heading as follows: "Do not use on cats less than 6 months of age or weighing less than 9 pounds."

k. On page 8, Directions for Use, change the sixth statement as follows: "Use only on cats over 6 months of age and weighing 9 pounds or over."

l. On page 10, change this statement: "Kills 100% of the fleas on cats cats within 24 hours (and continues to prevent infestation for four weeks)" to the following: "Kills fleas on cats within 24 hours (and continues to prevent infestation for four weeks)". The claim of 100% control within 24 hours is not acceptable.

m. On pages 4 and 8, provide all optional pictures and graphics that you intend to use for demonstrating tube opening and application.

3. Within 24 months from the date of this letter, submit a transferrable residue study on cats. Prior to initiating this study, a protocol should be submitted to the Agency for review.

4. Within 12 months from the date of this letter, submit results of the one year storage stability (830.6317), and corrosion characteristics (830.6320) studies that are being conducted for this product.

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5. Submit production information for this product for the fiscal year in which this use is conditionally registered, in accordance with FIFRA section 29. The fiscal year begins October 1, and ends September 30. The production information will be submitted to the Agency no later than November 15, following the end of the preceding fiscal year.
