 - a. Change the product registration number to "EPA Reg. No. 2596-161"
 - b. Make the following label revisions:

General Statement(s):

1. Delete all text throughout the label marked with "strikethrough."

Efficacy-Review comment(s):

2. The cited tick data (MRID 42587308) were deemed acceptable by the Agency to support kills claims against ticks. However, because the cited study did not assess residual control on carpets, and is not adequate to support any residual claims for ticks. Only claims against killing those ticks that were contacted with this product at application are acceptable. The alternate label text claims must be modified to indicate this, or alternatively, further efficacy (product performance) data can be submitted or cited, for which the residual claims are supported based upon the indicated rates of product and its use directions. ¹

Precautionary Statements, Environmental Hazards section comment(s):

3. To facilitate inclusion of required language from the REDs for phenothrin and MGK 264 insecticide synergist, revise this section to read

"This product is highly toxic to aquatic organisms, including fish and invertebrates. Do not apply directly to water.  processing equipment and food preparation surfaces, or wash them before use.
- Do not apply this product in a way that will contact adults, children or pets, either directly or through drift.
- Do not allow adults, children, or pets to enter the treated area until dusts have settled.
- · Remove pets, birds and cover fish aquariums before application.
- Do not reapply this product more than once every 30 days.

To facilitate inclusion of required language from the RED for MGK 264 insecticide synergist, revise the 3rd enumerated use direction located at the bottom of page 2 of 3 to read "Shake powder lightly over area of carpet to be treated. Do not use this product on wet spots. Do not apply as a broad carpet treatment. Only spots less than 3 feet by 3 feet per room may be applied with this product."

Conditional Data Requirements:

- 7. Data deficiencies were identified for storage stability and corrosion characteristics in the product chemistry review for this product. Therefore, The Hartz Mountain Company is obligated to submit a One-Year Storage Stability (830.6317) study and a Corrosion Characteristics (830.6320) study on this product in support of this registration within one (1) year from the date of this registration. ²
- 3. Submit two (2) copies of the final printed labeling, incorporating the above changes, before releasing the product for shipment.

Should The Hartz Mountain Corporation wish to add/retain a reference to the company's website on your label, please be aware that the website becomes labeling under FIFRA and is subject to review by the Agency.
