- r. Remove the word "also" from the marketing claim: "Can also be used on breeding, pregnant and lactating bitches"
- s. Remove the following marketing claim: "Gentle protection for dogs and puppies)" This claim is an implied safety claim, and detracts from other mandatory precautionary label language on the label.
- t. Remove the marketing claims "Quick drying (formula)", and "Dries quickly" These claims conflict with the statement: "After application, the treated area may appear wet (or) (oily) for up to 24 hours."

- v. The marketing claim "New (formula)" is allowed for a period of 6 months from the date of this Notice of Registration.

- x. Revise the statement "For dogs and puppies 8 weeks of age or older." to: "Only for use on dogs and puppies 8 weeks of age or older."
- y. Revise the claim: "Specially formulated for dogs and puppies" to: ""Formulated for dogs and puppies 8 weeks of age or older."
- z. Replace the "(X)" in the following claims: "(X) month supply" and "(X) monthly treatment(s)" with a 3. This is the only package approved by CRP testing, and should be the only package size displayed on the label. Any other package design would require additional Child Resistant Packaging testing.
- aa. Remove the statements: "Fragrance-free" and "Unscented" Claims about the absence of an ingredient: Statements or claims that express the absence of certain ingredients may be misleading statements prohibited by 40 CFR 156.10 (a)(5). These claims are a statement used in such a way as to give a false and misleading impression to the purchaser.






