The amended label referred to above, submitted in connection with registration under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide and Rodenticide Act, as amended, is acceptable. This approval does not affect any conditions that were previously imposed on this registration. You continue to be subject to existing conditions on your registration and any deadlines connected with them.

A stamped copy of your labeling is enclosed for your records. This labeling supersedes all previously accepted labeling. You must submit one copy of the final printed labeling before you release the product for shipment with the new labeling. In accordance with 40 CFR 152.130(c), you may distribute or sell this product under the previously approved labeling for 18 months from the date of this letter. After 18 months, you may only distribute or sell this product if it bears this new revised labeling or subsequently approved labeling. "To distribute or sell" is defined under FIFRA section 2(gg) and its implementing regulation at 40 CFR 152.3.

Should you wish to add/retain a reference to the company's website on your label, then please be aware that the website becomes labeling under the Federal Insecticide Fungicide and Rodenticide Act and is subject to review by the Agency. If the website is false or misleading, the product would be misbranded and unlawful to sell or distribute under FIFRA section 12(a)(1)(E). 40 CFR 156.10(a)(5) list examples of statements EPA may consider false or misleading. In addition, regardless of whether a website is referenced on your product's label, claims made on the website may not substantially differ from those claims approved through the registration process. Therefore, should the Agency find or if it is brought to our attention that a website contains false or misleading statements or claims substantially differing from the EPA approved registration, the website will be referred to the EPA's Office of Enforcement and Compliance.

Your release for shipment of the product constitutes acceptance of these conditions. If these conditions are not complied with, the registration will be subject to cancellation in accordance


FREQUENCY OF APPLICATION

{Alternate Brand Name} kills ticks for one month. A once monthly application is recommended where tick control is needed. Although {Alternate Brand Name} can control fleas for up to six weeks, if there is a high risk of reinfestation or if the cat has fleas which may cause flea allergy dermatitis, a once monthly application may be needed.

To kill fleas, all stages of brown dog ticks, American dog ticks, lone star ticks, and deer ticks [which may carry Lyme disease], chewing lice and mosquitoes, apply to cats and kittens 8 weeks or older and weighing 3 lbs. or more as follows:

- 3. Position the dispensing tip on the cat's back between the shoulder blades. Use the dispensing tip of the [applicator tube][tube] to part the cat's hair so that the product will be applied at skin level. Squeeze [applicator tube][tube], applying entire contents in a single spot on the cat's skin. Separate treated cat from other [dogs and cats] [pets] for 24 hours after treatment has been applied.
