- e. Pictures: Hartz must place large, clear pictures of the appropriate species on the front panel.
- f. Revise the precautionary statements by replacing the sentence: "Harmful if swallowed." with "Harmful if swallowed or absorbed through the skin."
- g. Replace "Wash thoroughly with soap and water after handling." with "Wash thoroughly with soap and water after handling and before eating, drinking, chewing gum, using tobacco or using the toilet.

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- s. Revise the marketing claim as follows: "Provides fast, effective and convenient treatment and control of fleas, ticks, chewing lice and mosquitoes (for cats and kittens 8 weeks or older)
- t. Remove the following marketing claim: "Gentle protection for cats (and kittens)" This claim is an implied safety claim, and detracts from other mandatory precautionary label language on the label.
- u. Remove the marketing claims "Quick drying (formula)", and "Dries quickly" These claims conflict with the statement: "After application, the treated area may appear wet (or) (oily) for up to 24 hours."
- v. The marketing claim "New (formula)" is allowed for a period of 6 months from the date of this Notice of Registration.
- w. Remove the following statement: "Spreads with cat's natural skin oils" The Labeling Consistency Committee has deemed this misbranding under 40 CFR 156.10.
