The above-referenced registrations contain conditions as stated in the initial registration notice dated 7/9/2012. In addition to the time-limited registration, your company is required to adhere to the spot-on label mitigation, submit quarterly enhanced incident reports and quarterly sales information for each of the above registrations.

The Agency has found Hartz in compliance with the terms and conditions for the subject products. Therefore, the following change is being made to the terms and conditions of the products listed above: The 2-year time-limited registration restriction has been extended an additional two (2) years. Therefore, the new expiration date for the subject product registrations is now April 16, 2021.
