DIRECTIONS

A mild, non-caustic, and pleasant preparation for use in the home. Meets State of California specification for Pine Oil Disinfectant for general use. Forms a creamy white emulsion when mixed with water. Easily rinsed off.

DISINFECTANT: Use two ounces per gallon of water, or two teaspoonfuls to a pint. THOROUGHLY WASH ALL THINGS

INSECTICIDE FOR FLEAS: Use three tablespoonfuls per gallon of water as a dip or to bathe domestic animals for the control of fleas. A SPECIFIC FOR DOGS AND CATS.

Repeat regularly as needed. For use as a spray, mix one part with three parts of water and spray freely in animal sleeping quarters, floors, cracks, crevices, and runs. Repeat at regular intervals as needed.

DEODORANT: Use one part in twenty, to one part in 200 parts of water as a spray, mop, or scrub solution. Vary strength of solution as circumstances indicate. Recommended for public buildings, bathrooms, garbage cans, and other such areas as are applicable.
