DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

Do not apply this product in such a manner as to directly or through drift expose workers or other persons. The area being treated must be vacated by unprotected persons. Do not enter treated areas without protective clothing until sprays have dried.

For most effective results, use a good sprayer, adjusted to deliver a fine mist.

FOR FLYING INSECTS such as mosquitoes, flies, gnats: Close all doors and windows. Direct the spray to all parts of the room. Fill the room with mist, then leave the treated area. Keep room closed for at least 15-30 minutes. Ventilate the room when treatment is completed.

FOR CRAWLING INSECTS such as roaches, earwigs, grain mites, sowbugs, spiders and centipedes: Spray thoroughly into hiding places such as cracks, crevices, moist areas, openings around pipes, sinks and other points of entry under refrigerator, baseboards and storage areas. Spray directly on insects where possible. Repeat as necessary.

WASPS: Application should be made in late evening when insects are at rest. Spray liberally into hiding and breeding places, contacting as many insects as possible. Repeat as necessary.

ANTS: Spray trails, nests and points of entry. Spray on ants where possible. Repeat as necessary.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

Do not contaminate water, food or feed by storage or disposal.

PESTICIDE STORAGE & SPILL PROCEDURES:

Store upright at room temperature. Avoid exposure to extreme temperatures. In case of spill or leakage, soak up with an absorbent material such as sand, sawdust, earth, fuller's earth, etc. Dispose of with chemical waste.

PESTICIDE DISPOSAL: Pesticide spray mixture or rinse water that cannot be used according to label instructions must be disposed of at or by an approved waste disposal facility.
