Based on your response to the Silver Reregistration Eligibility Document, EPA has reregistered the above named product subject to the comments recorded in the succeeding paragraph. This action is taken under the authority of section 4(g)(2)(C) of the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide, and Rodenticide Act, as amended. Reregistration under this section does not eliminate the need for continual reassessment of pesticides. EPA may require submission of data at any time to maintain the registration of your product. Make the following labeling changes before you release the product for shipment: Make the following labeling changes listed below before you release the product for shipment:

- a. Add the phrase "EPA Registration No. 2623-5."
- b. Include the appropriate EPA Establishment No.
- c. In the revised label in the ingredient statement, the terms Active Ingredient and Inert ingredients should be aligned to the same left margin and the label claims should be "Metallic Silver" instead of "Silver."

- d. Revise the claim "Bacterial growth within this cartridge is inhibited" to read as follows:

"This product inhibits the growth of bacteria in the filter to prolong the life of the filter."

- e. The phrase, "Fine-Filters Asbestos", is not permitted and should be deleted from the product labeling.
- f. The statement "Cartridge should serve a family of four for one year when used with a separate faucet" must be more specific. It should give the number of gallons used per day. Revise the statement to read as follows:

"Cartridge should serve a family of four for one year when using four gallons per day."

- g. Delete the term "Municipally or non-community tap water treated" because it is misleading and should be removed according to the Safe Drinking Water Act and the National Interim Primary Drinking Water Regulations.
- h. Delete the term "General Classification" from the product labeling.
- i. Place the subheading "Directions for Use" directly above the misuse statement.
- j. Revise the statement "Providestap water" to read as follows:

"This product inhibits the growth of bacteria in the filter to prolong the life of the filter."

- k. Revise the statement "Removes residualodors" to read as follows:

"This product is designed to remove objectional tastes, odors, and color from municipally treated tap water."

- l. Place the statement "Keep Out of Reach of Children" directly above the signal word "Caution."
- m. Place the claim " Use with cold water only" on the product labeling as outlined in the product labeling requirements for the Silver RED.
- n. Delete the phrase "Premium Quality Water" from the product labeling. The phrase is considered misleading.
