Directions

FAMILY WASH — for a Jeaner, brighter family wash add ½ cup OCEAN PINE OIL to wash, along with your regular detergent. The penetrating action of OCEAN PINE OIL helps remove dirt, grease, and many stubborn stains.

BABY CLOTHES — To remove odors from diapers, presoak in $\frac{1}{2}$ cup per gallon of water. Wash baby clothes with $\frac{1}{2}$ cup per wash load in addition to regular detergent for hygienically clean, sweet smelling garments. To sanitize and stop odors from play pen, buggy, crib, etc., use two tablespoons per quart of water.

KITCHEN — To remove grease from stove, refrigerator, sink or other greasy objects, dampen cloth with OCEAN PINE OIL and wipe surface. A small amount poured down sink drain will cut grease and overcome food odors.

DOGS BATH — Add 3 tbsp. to each gallon of water to remove odors.
