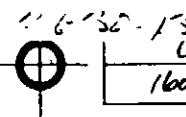

PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS

Hazards to Humans and Domestic Animals: May be harmful if swallowed, inhaled or absorbed through skin. Contains petroleum distillate. Do not induce vomiting because of aspiration hazard. Avoid breathing spray mist and provide adequate ventilation of area being treated. Avoid contact with skin, eyes and clothing. In case of contact, immediately flush skin and eyes with plenty of water. Wash thoroughly with soap and water after handling. If poisoning occurs, get prompt medical aid.

Do not apply directly to food. Do not apply while food processing is underway. All food processing surfaces and utensils should be covered during treatment or thoroughly washed before use.

Remove pets, birds and cover fish aquariums before spraying. Do not allow children or pets to contact treated surface until spray has dried.

Do not use this product in or on electrical equipment due to the possibility of shock hazard.

Environmental Hazards: This product is toxic to fish and other aquatic animals. Do not apply directly to lakes, streams or ponds. Do not contaminate water when disposing of equipment washwaters.

PHYSICAL OR CHEMICAL HAZARDS

Do not use or store near heat or open flame.

STATEMENT OF PRACTICAL TREATMENT

If swallowed: Do not induce vomiting because of aspiration hazard. Contact a physician or poison control center immediately.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

Spray Spray-In-Kill Flies, Mosquitoes, Small Flying Moths and Gnats. Cover or remove exposed food and food handling surfaces. Close room and shut off all air conditioning or ventilating equipment. Apply with mechanical hand sprayer or compressed air sprayer or with fogger which gives small particle size. Direct spray upwards toward upper corners of room and ceiling. Apply at the rate of 0.5 to 1.0 fluid ounces per 1,000 sq. ft. of space to be treated. Leave room closed for one half hour. Ventilate room thoroughly before re-entry. Repeat as necessary for insect control.

Crash-In-Surface Spray-In-Kill Roaches, Waterbugs and Ants. Cover or remove food before application as described under spray spray. Apply with a sprayer that gives large wetting droplets. Enter spray into cracks and crevices in walls and floors, areas at base of machinery, behind cabinets, around pipes and openings along baseboards and other insect harborage. Use one gallon of spray per 1,000 sq. ft. of surface to be treated. For ants, spray trails and all points of entry into the building. Spray ant nests directly with a shaking application. In all cases, contact as many insects as possible directly with the spray. Repeat application as necessary for control.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

Storage: Store in a cool, dry area away from heat or open flame.

Disposal: Securely wrap original container in several layers of newspaper and discard in trash.
