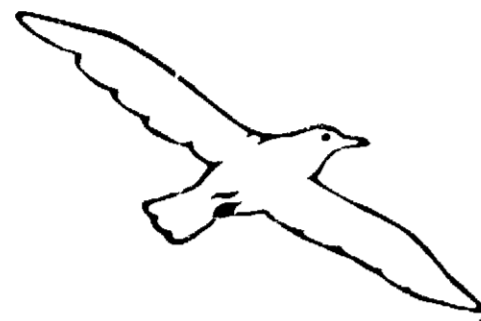

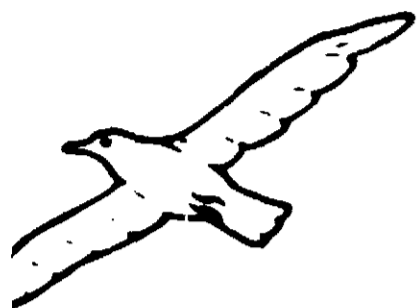

## DIRECTIONS FOR USING CLO-WHITE... Household favorite of millions

Clo-White may be used with any good soap or detergent.

● **USE CLO-WHITE EACH TIME YOU LAUNDRER FOR A CLEANER FAMILY WASH.** May be used on white or colorfast Cotton, Linen, Nylon, Rayon, Acetate, Dacron, Orlon, Acrilan, Kodel, Arnel and blends of these fibers. Bleaches, deodorizes, disinfects, removes stains.

● **MACHINE LAUNDRING:** For top-loading automatics and wringer washers, use 1 cup Clo-White per load; use 1/2 cup in front loading washers. If possible, add Clo-White to wash water before adding laundry. Otherwise, after machine starts and fabrics are saturated with water, add Clo-White which has been diluted in a quart of water. Rinse. If machine has an automatic bleach dispenser, follow washer directions.

● **HAND LAUNDRING:** Add 1 tbsp. Clo-White per gallon of water, mix thoroughly before adding wash.

● **DIAPER WASH:** First, flush out soiled drapers, then follow regular laundry procedure. Clo-White disinfects the wash as it whitens, deodorizes, removes stains.

### BLEACHABILITY TEST

If doubt exists about the use of Clo-White on colors or special fabrics for the first time, then test for color-fastness and bleachability. Soak a sample piece of the fabric in a solution of 1 tbsp. Clo-White to 1 gallon hot water. (If yellowing of white wash-and-wear fabrics occurs, sometimes caused by chlorine-sensitive finishes, this condition can usually be corrected with a color remover or whitener such as Ko-Kem Nylon Whitener.)

**NOTICE:** Used regularly in house cleaning, Clo-White is the most effective household disinfectant of its kind. Its cleansing qualities benefits the whole family and used as directed, Clo-White meets U. S. Public Health Service recommendations as a disinfecting solution.

### CLO-WHITE HOUSEHOLD CLEANING USES

to disinfect, deodorize and remove stains from:

bathubs	fruit jars	plastic	stoves
dishes	garbage cans	porcelain	teapots
drainboards	glassware	refrigerators	tile
enamelware	linoleum	showers	windows
floors	marble	sinks	woodwork

Using 3 tbsp. Clo-White to each quart of warm water, wash, then wipe area to be cleaned with cloth or vinyl sponge wet with above solution. Rinse, dry. (If stains persist, repeat above procedure keeping area damp with Clo-White solution for 5 minutes.) Do not use on aluminum, chipped enamelware, silver, steel.

**CAUTION:** Do not use Clo-White in conjunction with ammonia or toilet bowl cleaners as hazardous gases will be released harmful to breathe. Do not store any liquid other than Clo-White in this bottle.

**TOILET BOWLS:** After flushing, pour 1/2 cup Clo-White full strength into bowl, agitate over area to be cleaned, let stand 10 minutes, flush. For stubborn stains add a few drops of vinegar or lemon juice.

**NOT HARMFUL TO SEPTIC TANKS:** Regular use of Clo-White in home or on the farm has no adverse effect on septic tank operation.

● **STUBBORN STAINS** (blood, coffee, chocolate, fruit, grass, some inks and medicines, mildew, tea, vegetable, scorch, wine): Mix 2 tbsp. Clo-White in 1 quart cold water, or 1/2 cup Clo-White per gallon cold water. Soak entire garment 5 to 15 minutes. Thoroughly rinse in clear water. Repeat if necessary. Remove stains before laundering for best results.

● **SICKROOM SUPPLIES AND EQUIPMENT:** Wash thoroughly; soak 5 minutes in Clo-White solution (3 tbsp. to each quart hot water); rinse; drain dry. Disinfects, deodorizes, removes stains.

● **DENTURES:** To disinfect, sweeten and aid in removing stains. Clean dentures thoroughly then let stand 15 minutes or overnight in solution of 1/4 tsp. Clo-White to 1/2 glass (4 ozs.) water. (Not recommended for dentures with metal parts.)

● **DRINKING WATER PURIFICATION:** To help prevent bacterial contamination: Add 1 tbsp. Clo-White to 5 gallons of water, or 16 drops Clo-White per gallon, or 4 drops per quart. Mix well. Let stand for 5 minutes before drinking.

● **SWIMMING POOL:** To disinfect use 1 quart of Clo-White per 12,000 gallons of fresh water. Mix thoroughly the required amount of Clo-White with 20 parts of water and feed solution through a chlorinator, or dilute and scatter over surface of pool. Test frequently and add Clo-White as required to maintain 0.6 to 1.0 p.p.m. available chlorine. (Write for add. info.)

● **DAIRIES, CREAMERIES, RESTAURANTS, TAVERNS AND SODA FOUNTAINS:** First thoroughly clean surfaces to be disinfected (not utensils). Mix 1 tbsp. Clo-White to each gallon of water; apply solution for 5 minutes. (Meets U. S. Public Health Service recommendation -200 p.p.m. available chlorine.)
