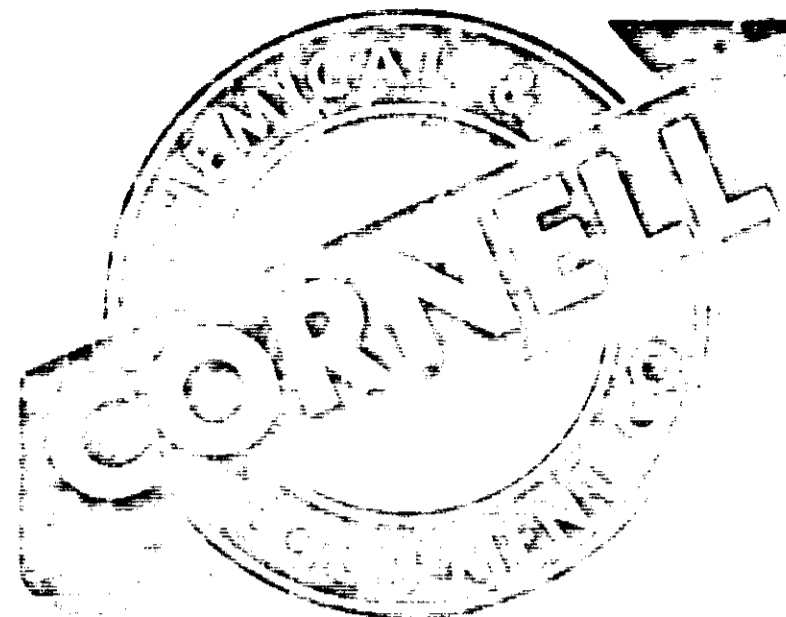
When used as directed, the residues of Cornell Grain-Gard will not affect the grade of germination of the grain to which it is applied.

Cornell Grain-Gard can be used on all types of ^{stored} corn, barley, wheat, oats, rye, rice and other small grains held in storage.

When properly applied, Cornell Grain-Gard should be effective for a full storage season or approximately 8 months.

DIRECTIONS:

Dilute Cornell Grain-Gard at rate of 1 part Grain-Gard with 29 parts of water. Agitate or mix well.

Apply at rate of 4 gallons of diluted Grain-Gard for every 1000 bushels of grain.

Apply as far away from storage as practical, so the grain will tumble two or three times before entering the ultimate storage bin. To obtain best results Cornell Grain-Gard is applied at an even rate onto grain as it is carried along a belt or as it enters the elevator or auger.

Inspect grain monthly. If the top two or three inches of grain are infested, treat at the rate of 1 to 2 gallons Cornell Grain-Gard per 1000 sq. ft. diluted 1 part with 29 parts of water.
