#### DIRECTIONS FOR USE

Shake a small amount of Cornell Ectoparasite Powder along the back of the animal from the neck to the rump, then ruffle the animal hair to allow the dust to sift down into the coat. Make second application one week later, then at one month intervals or as necessary. Avoid use on nursing animals.
