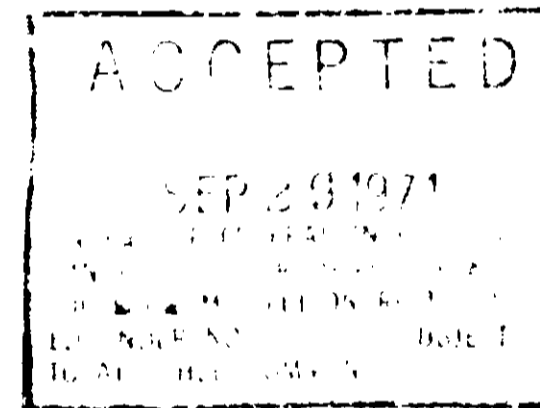

**DIRECTIONS FOR USE:**

**DOGS:** For protection against flies. Apply as a spray, misted, directly on animals so that the droplets will adhere to the coat of the dog. Avoid soaking hide of animals. Avoid the dog's eyes. Repeat when flies become troublesome.

**ANIMAL QUARTERS, FEED ROOMS & STORAGE AREAS:**  
For protection against flies, gnats, fleas and ticks. Mix 1 part DOG GARD to 9 parts water (4 tins, to 1 2 pt. water). Spray or paint this dilution directly on walls, partitions, cracks and recesses where insects hide. Repeat when necessary.

**CAUTION:** Do not spray directly on food. Keep out of reach of children. Harmful if swallowed. Avoid contamination of food stuffs. Do not spray into or near open flame. Do not smoke while spraying. Do not reuse empty container. Destroy if the container is damaged. Burn or discard empty container.
