The amendment referred to above, submitted in connection with registration under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide, and Rodenticide Act, is acceptable provided that you:

1. Make the labeling changes listed below before you release the product for shipment bearing the amended labeling:
  - a. Delete Sodium Carbonate and Trisodium Phosphate, Anhydrous from the active ingredients. They are now considered inert, and adjust your percentage accordingly.
  - b. Change "First Aid" to "Statement of Practical Treatment."
  - c. Delete "General Classification" and the word "milk."
  - d. Under the heading "Storage and Disposal," add the subheadings "Pesticide Disposal" and "Container Disposal." Refer to PR Notice 83-3.
  - e. As per your last submitted labels, we have adjusted our records to show your new product name as follows:

Cleaner, Disinfectant, Deodorant, SES-52.

- f. Revise the statement "Avoid contamination of foods. SBS-52 is harmful or fatal if swallowed. May cause burns or damage eyes" to read:

Corrosive. Causes severe eye and skin damage. Do not get in eyes, on skin, or on clothing. Wear goggles or face shield and rubber gloves when handling. Harmful if swallowed. Avoid contamination of food.

- g. Include the following statement:

Note to Physician


Probable mucosal damage may contraindicate the use of gastric lavage.

2. Submit five (5) copies of your final printed labeling before you release the product for shipment. Refer to the A-79 Enclosure for a further description of final printed labeling.

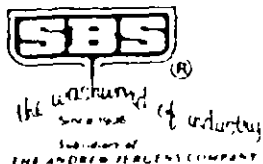
GENERAL CLEANING AND DISINFECTION in public rooms. Clean surfaces such as walls, floors, ceilings and woodwork thoroughly with a solution containing two ounces SBS-52 per gallon of warm water. Wipe with clean cloth or mop. Excellent for use in floor cleaning machines. Rinsing unnecessary.

SAFETY GEAR: To clean and disinfect safety wear such as eye-protection equipment, welding helmets, respirators, and rubber goods, scrub articles thoroughly with a solution containing two ounces SBS-52 per gallon of warm water. Rinse in clean water then soak articles for ten minutes in a solution containing one ounce SBS-52 per gallon of warm water. Flush with clean water. Articles may be air- or oven-dried.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

Do not contaminate water, food, or feed by storage or disposal. Completely empty bag into application equipment. Then dispose of empty bag in a sanitary landfill or by incineration, or, if allowed by State and local authorities, by burning. If burned, stay out of smoke.
