- a. Add the phrase, "EPA Registration No. 2686-10".
- b. The signal word is "Danger"
- c. Revise the precautionary statement to read:

DANGER: CORROSIVE. Causes irreversible eye damage or skin burns. Harmful if swallowed or adsorbed through skin or inhaled. Do not get in eyes, on skin or on clothing. Avoid breathing spray mist. Wear goggles or face shield. Wear protective clothing and rubber gloves. Wash thoroughly with soap and water after handling. Remove contaminated clothing and wash clothing before reuse.

STATEMENT OF PRACTICAL TREATMENT

IF IN EYES: Flush immediately with plenty of water while holding eyelids apart. Remove any contact lenses and continue flushing for 15 minutes. Call a poison control center or physician immediately.

IF ON SKIN: Flush immediately with plenty of water and wash affected area with mild soap and water. If symptoms persist, call a poison control center or physician.

IF INHALED: Remove person to fresh air. If breathing becomes difficult or symptoms develop, call poison control center or physician.

3. Submit five (5) copies of your final printed labeling before you release the product for shipment. Refer to the A-79 enclosure for a further description of final printed labeling.

If these conditions are not complied with, the registration will be subject to cancellation in accordance with FIFRA sec. 6(e). Your release for shipment of the product constitutes acceptance of these conditions.

HYDRI-SAN, No. 468 is a concentrated product and must be diluted before using. Recommended for use on precleaned, hard non-porous, environmental surfaces in food processing, milk manufacturing and dairy farms.

PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS

HAZARDS TO HUMANS AND DOMESTIC ANIMALS:

DANGER: Corrosive, causes eye and skin damage. Do not get in eyes, on skin, or on clothing. Wear goggles or face shield and rubber gloves when handling. Harmful or fatal if swallowed.

STATEMENT OF PRACTICAL TREATMENT

IF IN EYES: Flush with plenty of water for at least 15 minutes. Hold eyelids open while flushing with water. CALL A PHYSICIAN IMMEDIATELY.

IF ON SKIN: Wash thoroughly with soap and water. Remove and wash contaminated clothing before reuse.

IF SWALLOWED: If swallowed, DO NOT induce vomiting. Give large quantity of water. NEVER give anything by mouth to an unconscious victim. CALL A PHYSICIAN IMMEDIATELY.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

STORAGE: Store in a cool, dry place. Store in original container only. Do not store in unlabeled or mislabeled containers.

DISPOSAL: Do not contaminate water, food, or feed by storage or disposal. Do not use empty container. Triple rinse (or equivalent) and return to manufacturer or dispose of in accordance with local, state, and federal regulations.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

GENERAL CLASSIFICATION.

APPLICATIONS: For no rinse sanitizing in dairies and food processing plants.

IT IS A VIOLATION OF FEDERAL LAW TO USE THIS PRODUCT IN A MANNER INCONSISTENT WITH THE LABELING.

PREPARATION: Remove gross soils by flushing with water, scraping or brushing. Thoroughly preclean surface using an alkaline cleaner at 130°F-160°F. Rinse thoroughly with potable water.

SANITIZING HARD NON-POROUS SURFACES: (glass or stainless filters pipelines, silos, processing vats, bulk tanks and utensils): Sanitize previous cleaned equipment and utensils, dip, brush, or spray equipment with a solution of HYDRI-SAN No. 468 at 1 ounce to 5 gallons of water. Provides 200 ppm (parts per million) Dodecylbenzene Sulfonic ACID. ALLOW AT LEAST 2 MINUTES contact time. Allow equipment to drain well. Blow or air dry. When used at levels not exceeding 400 ppm Dodecylbenzene Sulfonic Acid, a potable water rinse is not required.

FOR MANUAL APPLICATIONS: Fresh solutions should be prepared daily or when solution appears dirty. For mechanical applications, used sanitizing solutions may not be reused for sanitizing application.

Mix only with water. Do not mix with products or solutions containing chlorine, lye, washing powders, or household chemicals. Not for use on galvanized surfaces or sinks, or concrete or terrazzo floors.

USE DILUTION: 1 ounce to 5 gallons
PHOSPHORUS CONTENT: Not over 14.3%
