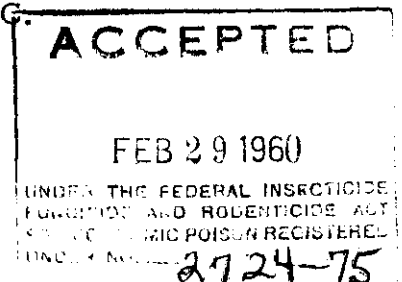

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

THE CONTROL OF BROWN DOG TICK on dogs, in kennels, and other areas is becoming more and more difficult.

KEMIC FLEA AND TICK POWDER has been developed especially to aid in the control of Brown Dog Ticks on dogs and premises. It is also very effective against fleas on dogs and cats.

KEMIC is also an effective fungicide for skin fungi which cause scratching and odors.

FOR CONTROL OF TICKS AND FLEAS ON DOGS AND CATS: Dust powder liberally over the animal and rub thoroughly into the skin. Be sure to apply also to the feet, between the toes, and on the legs. Comb out dead ticks a few hours after treatment. Repeat at weekly intervals if needed.

IN KENNELS, DOG HOUSES, ETC.: Dust in and around sleeping quarters and other areas where ticks and fleas occur.
