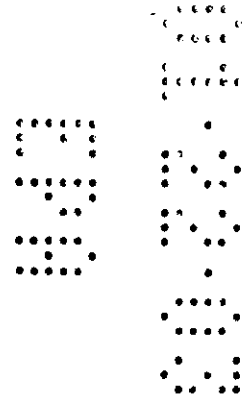

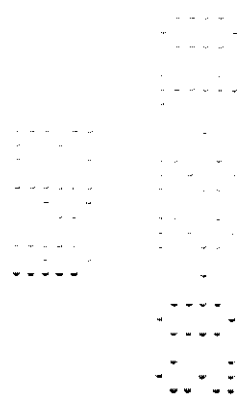

DIRECTIONS FOR USE: It is a violation of Federal Law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

Kemic may be used as an aid in the control of Brown Dog Ticks on dogs, cats, and premises and is effective against fleas on dogs and cats.

This product should not be applied by children. Use product only outside or in a well-ventilated area.

For control of ticks and fleas on dogs and cats: Wearing household latex or rubber gloves, dust entire animal, avoiding pet's eyes, nose, mouth, and genital areas. Rub or brush pet's hair to work dust down to the skin. Be sure to apply also to the feet, between the toes, and on the legs. Comb out dead ticks a few hours after treatment.

When dusting mother dogs or cats, remove the mother for treatment and return her to the puppies or kittens after one or two hours. Repeat every week if needed.

In kennels, dog houses: Dust in and around sleeping quarters and other areas where ticks and fleas occur. Dust pet bedding and doghouse using a shaker can or other dust applicator.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL: **Storage:** Store in original closed container away from children. **Disposal: If empty:** Do not reuse this container. Place in trash or offer for recycling if available. **If partly filled:** Call your local solid waste agency or 1-800-CLEANUP for disposal instructions. Never place unused product down any indoor or outdoor drain.

PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS

HAZARDS TO HUMANS AND DOMESTIC ANIMALS - CAUTION: May be harmful if swallowed. Avoid breathing dust. Avoid contact with eyes, skin, or clothing. Wash thoroughly after handling. Do not use this product in places where food is prepared or processed. Consult a veterinarian before using this product on debilitated, aged, animals on medication, or nursing animals. Do not use on pregnant dogs or cats. Do not use on kittens or puppies under 12 weeks of age. Sensitivities may occur after using ANY pesticide product for pets. If signs of sensitivity occur bathe your pet with mild soap and rinse with large amounts of water. If signs continue, consult a veterinarian immediately. Do not use this product on animals simultaneously or within 30 days before or after treatment with or exposure to cholinesterase inhibiting drugs, pesticides, or chemicals.

NOTE TO PHYSICIAN/VETERINARIAN: Atropine and homatropine are antidotal only if symptoms of cholinesterase inhibition are present. Usual symptoms in animals include salivation, labored breathing, incoordination, and pin-point pupils.

- Change clothing as soon as possible after use, wash clothing before reuse.
