Directions for use

Thuron Blue Sugar Bait is a fly bait formula which can be scattered as a dry bait to give initial knockdown and reduction of the fly population.

DRY BAIT: For reducing populations of houseflies in and around dairy barns, livestock barns, poultry houses, feed lots, kennels, refuse piles, and other areas where houseflies are a problem, scatter at the rate of approximately ¼ lb. per 500 sq. ft. of fly feeding area. Apply daily until the fly population is under control and thereafter as often as necessary. May be used around poultry and meat processing plants.


