Your Application Dated July 30, 1982

The labeling referred to above, submitted in connection with registration under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide and Rodenticide Act, as amended, is acceptable. A stamped copy is enclosed for your records.

Please note that our request of July 26, 1972, to add the standard non-food area use pattern precaution, has never appeared on submitted labeling. Unless the use in food processing plants or commercial food preparation areas is clearly excluded on the label, you must add the comment: "Do not use in edible product areas of food processing plants, restaurants or other areas where food is commercially prepared or processed. Do not use in serving areas while food is exposed." We do not feel that the use sites "Apartments, Homes, or Buildings" necessarily excludes use in food processing plants or commercial food preparation areas, especially since the label states "All food processing surfaces should be covered during treatment or thoroughly cleaned before using" and "Apply only when the facility is not in operation." We would appreciate inclusion of the requested precaution prior to marketing with the updated labeling. Please send five (5) copies of the revised labeling as soon as they become available to complete the product file for this action.
