

DIRECTIONS FOR USE: Remove the collar from package and place around cat's neck, adjust for proper fit and buckle in place. Collar must be worn loosely, but securely enough to prevent easy removal and loss of the collar. Cut off any excess length of collar, leaving ample length for expansion as the cat grows. Dispose of excess collar by discarding in trash.

Check and adjust collar periodically to assure a proper fit.

Do not use on kittens under 6 weeks of age.

RESULTS EXPECTED: The flea collar starts killing fleas and ticks when it is placed around the cat's neck. The fleas on the cat will be killed and new ones which may temporarily appear on the cat will be killed during the 4 months (17 weeks) collar is worn. Ticks are tough occasional pests of cats and will be killed within a few days. This product has been shown to provide effective Brown Dog tick control up to 3 months. For continuous protection, replace collar when effectiveness diminishes.

ACTIVE INGREDIENT:

Carbaryl (1-naphthyl N-methylcarbamate) 8.5%

INERT INGREDIENTS: 91.5%

CAUTION: Do not open inner envelope until ready to use. Do not allow children to play with this collar. This collar is intended for use as an insecticide generator and is not to be taken internally by man or animal. Not intended for use on humans.

Some animals may be sensitive to this collar. Any collar, when fastened too tightly, may cause skin irritation. If irritation persists after proper adjustment, remove the collar. Do not use any other pesticide on cat while collar is worn. Do not use on sick or convalescing animals.

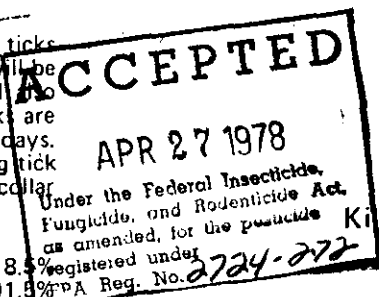
