DIRECTIONS FOR USE: It is a violation of Federal Law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

Do not open inner envelope until ready to use.

Remove the collar from package and place around cat's neck, adjust for proper fit and buckle in place. Collar must be worn loosely, but securely enough to prevent easy removal and loss of the collar. Cut off any excess length of collar, leaving ample length for expansion as the cat grows. Dispose of excess collar by discarding in trash.

Check and adjust collar periodically to assure a proper fit.

RESULTS EXPECTED: The flea collar starts killing fleas and ticks when it is placed around the cat's neck. The fleas on the cat will be killed and new ones which may temporarily appear on the cat will also be killed during the 4 months (17 weeks) collar is worn. Ticks are tough occasional pests of cats and will be killed within a few days. This product has been shown to provide effective Brown Dog tick control up to 3 months. For continuous protection, replace collar when effectiveness diminishes.

STORAGE & DISPOSAL: Store in original unopened container; away from children. Do not reuse container or used collar. Wrap and put in trash.

INERT INGREDIENTS:..... 91.5%

CAUTION: May be harmful if swallowed. Avoid contact with eyes, skin or clothing. Wash thoroughly after handling.

Do not use on kittens under 6 weeks of age.

Some animals may be sensitive to this collar. Any collar, when fastened too tightly, may cause skin irritation. If irritation persists after proper adjustment, remove the collar. Do not use any other pesticide on cat while collar is worn. Do not use on sick or convalescing animals.
