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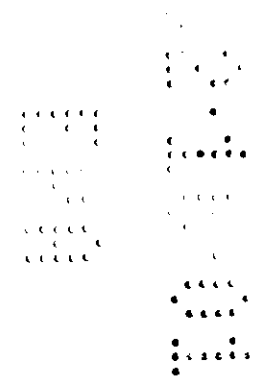

**DIRECTIONS FOR USE:** It is a violation of Federal Law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

1. Buckle collar around cat's neck. [Thread flat end of the collar through buckle hole and tighten as necessary, so that at least two ridges are covered by the buckle. Since the plastic buckle is molded into the collar, the possibility of neck irritation and buckle failure is reduced.] Fit collar snug enough to prevent placement of the cat's leg or lower jaw through the collar, yet loose enough to be rotated about the neck.
2. Leave 1-2 extra inches on the collar for adjustment, cut off excess length and dispose of in trash.
3. Check periodically and adjust fit if necessary, especially when kittens are rapidly growing.
4. May be used in addition to regular collar. Replace collar every 4 months if necessary. [To release the collar, squeeze buckle between thumb and finger and pull sharply.]

[for "breakaway" versions]

[UNIQUE FEATURE: This collar is designed to stretch under the weight of an average size adult cat. It helps the cat to free itself ("breakaway") if the collar gets snagged on a fixed object. If the collar is fitted improperly, so that it is loose enough for a cat to be able to work the collar over its leg or jaw, this release feature may not stretch adequately to allow the cat the extra room necessary to free itself.]

**STORAGE and DISPOSAL:** Store in original unopened container away from children. Do not reuse container or ~~used~~-reuse collar. Wrap and put in trash.

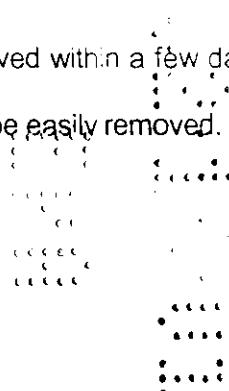
**WHAT TO EXPECT:**

**For Fleas:**

1. This [brand name] collar is designed to kill adult fleas.
2. This collar starts killing fleas as soon as it is placed around the cat's neck.
3. Protection against fleas will be achieved within a few days, providing continuous protection for [up to] 4 months [17 weeks].
4. Replace collar every 4 months to help control [prevent] flea infestations on your pet and in your home.

**For Brown Dog Ticks:**

1. Ticks are tougher to kill than fleas and are killed more slowly.
2. Full protection against adult and immature Brown Dog ticks will be achieved within a few days, providing continuous protection for [up to] 3 months.
3. Adult ticks will be killed over the entire pet. Dead ticks will fall off or may be easily removed.

**HAZARDS TO HUMANS AND DOMESTIC ANIMALS - CAUTION:**

**Humans:** Do not open [package][inner envelope] until ready to use. Do not allow children to play with this collar. May be harmful if swallowed. Avoid contact with eyes, skin, or clothing. Wash hands thoroughly with soap and water after handling collar.

**Animals:** Do not use on kittens under 12 weeks of age. Consult a veterinarian before using this product on debilitated, aged, medicated, pregnant, or nursing animals. Sensitivities may occur after using ANY pesticide product for pets. If signs of sensitivity occur, remove collar and bathe your pet with mild soap and rinse with large amounts of water. Do not use this product on animals simultaneously or within 30 days before or after treatment with or exposure to cholinesterase inhibiting drugs, pesticides, or chemicals. However, flea and tick collars may be immediately replaced.

**FIRST AID:** If Swallowed, call a physician/veterinarian or Poison Control Center. Drink 1 or 2 glasses of water and induce vomiting by touching back of throat with finger.
