DIRECTIONS FOR USE: It is a violation of Federal Law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

- 1. Buckle collar around dog's neck. [Thread flat end of the collar through buckle hole and tighten as necessary, so that at least two ridges are covered by the buckle. Since the plastic buckle is molded into the collar, the possibility of neck irritation and buckle failure is reduced.] Collar should fit snug enough to prevent placement of the dog's leg or lower jaw through the collar, yet loose enough to be rotated about the neck. [Generally, if used on large dogs, two or three fingers should fit between the collar and dog's neck.]
- 2. Leave 1-2 extra inches on the collar for adjustment, cut off excess length and dispose of in trash.
- 3. Check periodically and adjust fit if necessary, especially when puppies are rapidly growing.
- 4. May be used in addition to regular collar. Replace collar every 4 months if necessary. [To release the collar, squeeze buckle between thumb and finger and pull sharply.]

STORAGE and DISPOSAL: Store in original unopened container away from children. Do not reuse container or used collar. Wrap and put in trash.

WHAT TO EXPECT:

For Fleas:

- 1. This [brand name] collar is designed to kill adult fleas....
- 2. This collar starts killing fleas as soon as it is placed around dog's neck.
- 3. Protection against fleas will be achieved within a few days, providing continuous protection for 4 months.

For Ticks:

- 1. Ticks are tougher to kill than fleas and are killed more slowly.
- 2. Full protection against adult and immature ticks will be achieved within a few days, providing continuous protection for 1 month, and will aid in tick control for an additional month. [If your dog goes swimming or is out in the rain, it is not necessary to remove the collar. The continuous action will rapidly replace any flea and tick killing material removed.]
- 3. Adult ticks will be killed over the entire pet. Dead ticks will fall off or may be easily removed.

Sensitivities may occur after using ANY pesticide product for pets. If signs of sensitivity occur, remove collar and bathe your pet with mild soap and rinse with large amounts of water. Do not use this product on animals simultaneously or within 30 days before or after treatment with or exposure to cholinesterase inhibiting drugs, pesticides, or chemicals. However, flea and tick collars may be immediately replaced.

FIRST AID: If Swallowed, call a physician/veterinarian or Poison Control Center. Drink 1 or 2 glasses of water and induce vomiting by touching back of throat with finger. If person is unconscious, do not give anything by mouth and do not induce vomiting. If in Eyes, flush eyes with plenty of water. Call a physician if irritation persists. 




Clip end of collar to a point (Illustration A)
