CSF

The Agency has reviewed your submission for a revised Confidential Statement of Formula (CSF). The Confidential Statements of Formula dated 3/19/2008 for a basic and an alternate formulation are acceptable. The change dropped the percentage of active ingredient from 1.1% to 1.0%. Revised ingredients were found to be similar to previous ingredients. The ingredient percentages and limits comply with PR Notice 91-2. Enclosed please find a copy of the 6/17/2008 chemistry review by SMalak. The basic and alternate Confidential Statements of Formula have been added to your file as part of the record. These replace all previous versions.

LABEL

In association with the CSF change, the revised labeling reference to above, submitted in connection with the registration under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide, and Rodenticide Act (FIFRA), as amended, is ACCEPTABLE. Submit two (2) copies of your final printed labeling incorporating the above changes prior to releasing your product for shipment. If the above provisions are not complied with the registration will be subject to cancellation in accordance with FIFRA Section 6(e). GOLDEN MALRIN® [Flytek®] Fly Killer is a fly bait formula containing MUSCAMONE® Fly Attractant which encourages both male and female flies to remain in the treated area, thus feeding on the bait.

GOLDEN MALRIN [FLYTEK] FLY KILLER IS NOT TO BE USED INSIDE OR AROUND HOMES, OR ANY OTHER PLACE WHERE CHILDREN OR PETS ARE LIKELY TO BE PRESENT.

Do not apply this product in a way that will contact workers or other persons. Only protected handlers may be in the areas during application. Do not contaminate feed and foodstuffs. [Do not use the can opener used to open this product on food containers. Use a separate can opener.] Do not apply where poultry or other animals, especially dogs and young calves, can pick it up or lick it. Do not use in homes or where milk is processed or stored. Do not feed treated garbage. Use only in areas inaccessible to food producing animals, children, and pets.

Do not use in edible product areas of food processing plants, restaurants, or other areas where food is commercially prepared or processed. Do not use in serving areas while food is present.

SCATTERBAITS:

Use GOLDEN MALRIN [Flytek] Fly Killer as a scatterbait only around the outside of certain commercial agricultural production facilities where children or pets will not be present, specifically feedlots, broiler houses, and livestock barns. Bait may be used on walkways in caged layer houses.

GOLDEN MALRIN [Flytek] Fly Killer may also be used as a scatterbait around the outside of the following commercial facilities: canneries, beverage plants, meat and poultry processing plants, food processing plants, and commercial refuse dumpsters which are fenced or otherwise enclosed. Do not use around commercial dumpsters which are not enclosed. Do not use around dumpsters in residential settings.

To avoid contact, distribute bait directly from [shaker] container or other device at the rate of approximately 1/4 lb [4 oz] per 500 sq ft [15 g pouch per 70 sq ft] of fly feeding area. Reapply on a daily basis to maintain control, when the fly population is large enough to consume 4 oz. of GOLDEN MALRIN [Flytek] Fly Killer within a 500 square feet area in 1 day. However, when fly populations decrease, consumption of the bait also decreases so reapply every 2-3 days to maintain adequate fly control. **DO NOT PUT IN PILES.** Keep 1 to 2 inch intervals between particles. **DO NOT ALLOW FOOD PRODUCING ANIMALS OR PETS TO HAVE ACCESS TO TREATED AREAS.**

BAIT STATIONS:

Use GOLDEN MALRIN [Flytek] fly bait in any commercial bait station secured at least 4 feet above the ground and inaccessible to food-producing animals, pets, and children in the following areas: stables, outside of milking parlors, kennels, fast food establishments, restaurants, commissaries, bakeries, supermarkets, refuse dumpsters, and warehouses. Do not use in edible product areas of food processing plants, restaurants, or other areas where food is commercially prepared or processed. Do not use in serving areas while food is present. Add 1 ounce of product to each of 4 bait stations and space the 4 stations as equally as possible within a 500 sq ft treatment area. Add product to replace amount consumed before the station is empty; do not exceed 1 ounce of GOLDEN MALRIN [Flytek] Fly Killer per station at any time. Reapply on a daily basis to maintain control, when the fly population is large enough to consume 4 oz. of GOLDEN MALRIN [Flytek] Fly Killer within a 500 square feet area in 1 day. However, when fly populations decrease, consumption of the bait also decreases so reapply every 2-3 days to maintain adequate fly control. Replace bait station if physically damaged.

STORAGE and DISPOSAL

Do not contaminate water, food, or feed by storage or disposal.

Storage: Store the product in a dry, cool place not reachable by children.

Pesticide Disposal: Wastes resulting from the use of this product may be disposed of on site or at an approved waste disposal facility. **Pouch Disposal:** Do not reuse empty pouch. Wrap and put in trash collection. **Container Disposal: (can)** Triple rinse (or equivalent). Then offer for recycling or reconditioning, or puncture and dispose of in a sanitary landfill or by other approved state and local procedures. **Container Disposal: (drum)** Completely empty liner by shaking and tapping sides and bottom to loosen clinging particles. Empty residue into application equipment. Then dispose of liner and drum in a sanitary landfill or by incineration if allowed by state and local authorities.
